MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY - MLT

A Medical Laboratory Technician (MLT) performs, evaluates, correlates, and assures accuracy and validity of laboratory information, directs and supervises clinical laboratory resources and operations, and collaborates in the diagnosis and treatment of patients. Medical Laboratory Technologists (MLTs) are an important part of the health care professional team.

BSc Medical Laboratory Technology

The degree in medical laboratory technology provides advanced skills to practicing laboratory professionals in health administration, leadership, quality assurance and health informatics. The course of study enhances student’s knowledge and skills in several major categorical areas of medical laboratory technology.

Objectives & scope of course : At the end of the course the candidates shall be:

- ❖ Aware of the principles underlying the organization of a clinical laboratory
Able to do routine and special investigative procedures in medical laboratory practice
- ❖ Provide a good theory and practical education to the students who plan to work within the field of medical laboratory technology and science.
- ❖ Develop knowledge and skill in accordance with the society's demand in medical laboratory technology.
- ❖ Qualify the students for official approval as medical laboratory technician.
- ❖ Able to operate and maintain all equipment used in laboratory diagnostics
- ❖ Able to establish and manage a Clinical or Research laboratory

The four-year BSc MLT course at our college is provisionally affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur. The same university is authorized to conduct the examinations and grants the certificate. In addition, students attending BSc MLT course are professionally trained in Samaritan Hospital.

ADMISSION

1. Admission to the course will be based on merit. Candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or Equivalent examination recognized by any of the universities in the state of Kerala with 50% marks in physics, chemistry biology and English put together are eligible for admission
2. 50% of the total seats of the courses have been fixed by Govt. quota and 50% of the total seats of the course have been fixed by Samaritan Institute of Paramedical Sciences.
3. Candidate who has passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of the interview.
4. The applicant should have completed 17 years of age at the time of the admission. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
5. The student shall pay the fees for the first year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded

6. DOCUMENTS TO BE REQUIRED

- a) SSLC or equivalent certificate to prove date of birth
- b) Mark list of qualifying Examination (HSC/equivalent)
- c) Transfer Certificate
- d) Conduct Certificate
- e) Migration Certificate
- f) Nativity Certificate
- g) 4 copy of passport size photograph

7. HOW TO APPLY

- i. All candidates applying under management Quota, the application should be submitted by an online payment of Rs. 500 on our website www.samaritanhospital.in
- ii. Belated applications will be rejected. Candidates are therefore advised to apply well in time.

8. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION

- i. Selection will be based on the marks obtained in the on the qualifying examinations and the rank list prepared accordingly.
